- Eight separate 15-inch square sandwiches made of a top, cotton batting and lining (backing). Light solid fabric colors or muslin.

Elements of Machine Quilting

With Nina McVeigh

The silk fabric we'll be using in the kit will be a light ice blue. We'll be doing some decorative stitching so you'll want various threads.

- polyester embroidery threads---Mettler Polysheen or Isacord #3761 matches fabric. However, many shades of blue including navy are suitable.
- Superior Rainbow variegated threads
- metallic threads if desired
- size 75-90 machine quilting needles 1 pkg.
- size 80 universal needles 1 pkg.
- size 90 topstitch needles 1 pkg.
- size 80 metafil or metalica needles 1 pkg. if using metallic threads
- chalk marker
- rotary cutter w/new blade, mat and ruler at least 14-inches long
- scissors
- seam ripper
- straight pins
- notebook and pencil
